New International (NIV), English Standard (ESV), or Christian Standard (CSB) versions — each of these are written at about a 6th grade reading level

Avoid studying from a paraphrase — The Message, Living Rible, etc. are all great for helping understand, but do your study and note-taking from a translation instead. NOTE: We will use the ESV for this study.

Use colored pencils to mark in your Bible –

yellow -- key ideas

orange -- memory verses

blue -- God/Holy Spirit

brown -- people

green -- places

pink -- prophecy

red - Jesus
