



...Grace Group... .Guidelines.

- 1. God's Word is our standard. We'll use the Bible not personal opinion, popular teachers, or church tradition as our guide for everything. We are using the New English Translation (NET) Bible for this study, but you can use any trustworthy Bible translation (not a paraphrase) to study from.
- 2. We come from varying religious & political backgrounds. Remember: 'In essentials, unity; in non-essentials, liberty; in all things, charity.'
- **3.** Avoid commentaries or study notes in your Bible do your own thinking. Trust God, pray, ask for wisdom then read and answer on your own.
- 4. We're all learning. Be gracious and patient with yourself and with others. No one has it all figured out.
- 5. This is a Bible study not a personal-opinion group. So, there are going to be "right" and "wrong" answers in keeping with the truth of God's Word.
- 6. Share or Listen. You don't have to share, but if you did the reading and responded to that prompt, why not chime in? We all benefit from one another's thoughts and questions. I bet you have something great to share!
- 7. Done or Not Done...Come. Didn't finish the study this week? That's ok. Life gets busy. You're here! Yay, you! This will be a good week for you to listen and be encouraged by others.
- 8. Pe considerate. Share your thoughts on questions you completed and allow time for others to do the same limit yourself to about 2 minutes maximum and try to stay on topic. Your group leader will help with that.
- 9. A Pray. Pray when you arrive, while you're in Grace Groups, during teaching time. Pray for your understanding to grow. Pray for your Grace Group leaders. Pray for one another. Let's be women who go to the Father for one another and seek His face together.

...Read & Engage...

Welcome Back to Corinth! In this lesson you'll be reading through a letter that the Apostle Paul wrote to Christians in Corinth, the capital city of Achaia about 40 miles west of Athens. Today, we say, "2nd Corinthians" and refer to it as a "book of the Bible", but in A.D. 55 when Paul was writing, this was called an epistle or letter to a church community that Paul had established on his missionary trip through Asia. Paul knew these Christians personally. He was aware of the issues going on in their community and he had great love and concern for them. You felt this passion in First Corinthians and you will feel it even

more personally in this letter. In fact, as you read you'll find out more about Paul as a person than any other letter in the Bible. The doctrines of our faith are woven in and through Paul's testimony. This is a more personal account and you'll be blessed hearing from Paul's own heart in this letter. I found it to be inspiring, relatable, and astounding as I thought about all that Paul went though and how passionate and faithful he remained. The goal of this lesson is to give you an overview of this letter. We won't be digging in just yet.

This is more of a fly-over and the lessons to come will be a driving tour. Use a highlighter to note people, places, key verses as you read through these chapters.

• The Point. Read 2nd Corinthians. Don't allow yourself to become overwhelmed with the content. We will study 2nd Corinthians for the next several weeks - for now, simply read and let the Word of God dwell in you.

• **Big Picture.** Focus on grasping the "big picture" idea. What do you read about the nature of God? Any key words or themes? What surprises you? Confuses you? What connections are you making with other concepts in the Bible?

- Ask: "How does this passage point to the theme of "Love & Light"?
- Knowing God... The most important thing you'll ever know from the Bible is understanding the character and nature of God. Look for ways that God is revealed in every passage you read. Make it your aim to know Him.

As you read, use the table to organize details from each category. There may not be a detail in each passage, so leave it blank or create your own category for that passage if that is helpful.

Create & Share

Day Ten is set aside as a special "Create & Share" day. The idea is tied to the Dwelling Richly concept that we don't just "do"

Bible study we move with it, live in it, think, engage, and bring our ideas out into our real life with it.

So, on Day Ten we take what we've been reading and learning and dwelling upon and bring it all together to create something new and personal, then share it to bless someone.

Jesus was the ultimate example to us of exactly what this day is set aside for...creating and sharing. Everywhere Jesus Christ went he created. He is the epitome of all of creation and is one with God as the Creator. He is our beautiful example to follow as he shared not only in the simple acts of kindness but in the stunning and miraculous acts of sharing his healing power.

We were made in His image - to do and be and live like Him - not just because that's what a good Christian "should" do, but because we are most like Jesus when we imitate Him and live up to His image within us. So, our **Create & Share** time is not just another "step" in our Bible study - it is literally fulfilling what we have been called to do, "be imitators of God as dearly loved children."
