



Lesson Twelve Day One

...Grace Group... .Guidelines.

1.  **God's Word is our standard.** We'll use the Bible - not personal opinion, popular teachers, or church tradition - as our guide for everything. We are using the New English Translation (NET) Bible for this study, but you can use any trustworthy Bible translation (not a paraphrase) to study from.
2.  **We come from varying religious & political backgrounds.** Remember: 'In essentials, unity; in non-essentials, liberty; in all things, charity.'
3.  **Avoid commentaries or study notes in your Bible** - do your own thinking. Trust God, pray, ask for wisdom then read and answer on your own.
4.  **We're all learning.** Be gracious and patient with yourself and with others. No one has it all figured out.
5.  **This is a Bible study** - not a personal-opinion group. So, there are going to be "right" and "wrong" answers in keeping with the truth of God's Word.
6.  **Share or Listen.** You don't have to share, but if you did the reading and responded to that prompt, why not chime in? We all benefit from one another's thoughts and questions. I bet you have something great to share!
7.  **Done or Not Done...Come.** Didn't finish the study this week? That's ok. Life gets busy. You're here! Yay, you! This will be a good week for you to listen and be encouraged by others.
8.  **Be considerate.** Share your thoughts on questions you completed and allow time for others to do the same - limit yourself to about 2 minutes maximum and try to stay on topic. Your group leader will help with that.
9.  **Pray.** Pray when you arrive, while you're in Grace Groups, during teaching time. Pray for your understanding to grow. Pray for your Grace Group leaders. Pray for one another. Let's be women who go to the Father for one another and seek His face together.




5. **Succumbing to Cunning or Proactively Captive.** Connect Paul's teaching in 2 Cor 10:5 and 11:3-4. What is his warning? How does he compare the Corinthians to the events of Genesis 3? Note especially how Paul describes the ideal relationship with Christ and the nature of the deception he's warning against.

6. **Sarcasm Has its Place.** How does Paul sarcastically refer to the others who have come teaching their "gospel?"

How does Paul describe himself in 11:5-6?

7. **Satan's Deceptive Ways.** Read Genesis 3:1-6 and compare that encounter with the issue going on in Corinth and even in churches today? How have Satan's tactics changed? Remained the same?



8. **Living in Love and Light.** Think about your church and your Bible study group. Do you think your church could follow the way that Corinthians were headed? What kinds of things do you think would happen to allow for that deception? How will you be on the alert? How will you personally be proactive in making sure your church or Bible study group does not become deceived? **Challenge:** Tie in one key scripture from 1 Corinthians and one key scripture from 2 Corinthians to support your response.

4. **The Example of the Macedonians.** Once again, we learn of the Macedonian church and the example they set and the freedom this gave Paul in his ministry. Describe their example and what that enabled Paul to do:

5. **No Strings Attached.** How does *not* accepting money from the Corinthians impact Paul's ministry with them - hint, there's a "negative" as well as positive impact. (11:9-10 and other verses)

6. **Known by God and Knowing God.** Read Revelation 2:2. How is Paul's confidence in his pure motives before God evident in this passage? What does this say to you (1) about the nature of God and (2) about Paul's personal relationship with Jesus Christ? (11:10-11)

Think about your relationship with those in your church or Bible study group...Do you have the same confidence Paul does in how God sees your love for others? Something to think and pray about. 🙏

7. **Taking Money or Taking Advantage?** How is Paul's mission distinct from that of the "super apostles?" (11:12)

8. **Like Father, Like Son. Like Master, Like Slave.** How does Paul demonstrate awareness and calling out the Satanic ministry going on in Corinth? Review 2 Cor 2:11 and 11:4 in light of 11:12-15. Specifically list all the ways Paul describes these "super apostles."







8. **Final Commands.** Note the six things Paul admonishes/commands the Corinthians to do: (13:11-12) Select one of these and consider how you can apply that in your church today.
9. **Living in Love & Light.** How does each person of the Trinity impact your life and faith and faithfulness today? Consider Paul's final words to the Corinthians in 13:14 as you think about this in your own life.
