




## Numbers 1-2 – Pointing (literally) to Jesus

1:1-3 The Lord spoke to Moses in the wilderness ..."Take a census of all the congregation of the people of Israel...From twenty years old and upward, all in Israel who are able to go to war,






And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split. Matt. 27:51
