

What's Next?

The Dwelling Richly study will be on break through August 2024.

In the Fall, Lord willing, we will begin a new 5-lesson study through Galatians! I'm excited to make the connection from our time through the Torah into Paul's epistle (letter) to a church of new Christians who are growing in their faith and need some guidance! This letter is very much a "Saved & Set Apart" part 2 and a wonderful next step in our own faith! I hope you'll join us for that study.

Save the Date: September 10 or 11, 2024

As of now we are planning on the same basic schedule for Bible study: Every other week... Tuesdays, 6-8pm (same as Men's study and Youth Group) Wednesdays, 10-Noon or 6-8pm

Look for updates beginning in late July as we finalize the calendar for the fall study.

What Now?

I encourage you to continue to dwell in the Word with a Bible study buddy over the summer.

Ideas:

There are 4 months or 19 weeks or 133 days before our next study begins. In that time, you could:

- Read a book of the Bible together decide on a good pace and check in with each other as you read sharing your thoughts and questions and encouragement Ideas to read with a buddy: Joshua, Proverbs, Psalms, Luke, Romans
- **Read Proverbs one chapter a day**. Begin May 1 and end August 31 doing so will give you a wonderful journey through Proverbs!
- Read and Write Psalm 119 there are 176 verses in this Psalm. You could write 8 verses a week and you'd be done by the time we begin Galatians! What a wonderful way to dwell!
- **Read and meditate on one Psalm a week** For example: Psalm chapter one through Psalm chapter 19. Or One Psalm a day! Psalm 1 through 133.
- Do a Dwelling Richly study with a friend I have a 40-Day study through Romans, a lovely study through Ruth and Esther called "Faithful & Fearless", a study in James and a study called "Hope in the Lord" any of these could be completed this summer
- Use the Dwelling Richly approach: Pray, Memorize, Read, Write, Connect, Worship, Create & Share through any passage, chapter, or book of the Bible.
