Joshua 21:1-45 || Every Promise Fulfilled

- כֹּהֵן (ko-HANE)—priest.
- בֵּית יִשְׂרָאֵל—bêt Yisra'el, the house of Israel.
- נָתַן (nātan)—to give appears three times in those verses:
The LORD gave _____.
- The LORD gave _____.
- The LORD gave _____.

Joshua 22:1-20 || Misplaced Assumptions/Fractured Unity/Zeal Guided by Grace

- שָׁבוּת (shah-VOOT)—to return.
- חֵטָא (chet)—sin
- קִנְיָה (kin-AH)—a passionate, almost jealous devotion

Joshua 22:21-34 || Choose humility/Speak truth

- עֵד (eyd)—witness.
- עֲבָדָה (ah-voh-DAH)—service, worship.
- שְׁלוֹמִים (shalom)—peace.

Joshua 23:1-16 || The only path to covenant life and lasting blessing.

- דָּבַק (da-VAHK)—to stick, to cleave, to be inseparably joined.

Joshua 24:1-13 || : God’s covenant faithfulness in real places, people, and promises

- שֶׁכֶם (sha-KHEM)—Shechem.
- נָתַן (nātan)—to give—He gave Abraham a son.
- צָעַק (tsa-AHK)—to cry out in desperation, in anguish.

Joshua 24:14-28 || God has been faithful—now it’s your turn to choose.

- Cities of Refuge (מִקְלָט) reveal God’s justice and mercy.
 - Jesus is our better miklat—our refuge and high priest.
 - No one is too far from grace. The gates are open.
1. “Fear the LORD...” (v. 14) יָרָא (yah-RAY)—to fear.
 2. “...and serve Him in sincerity and faithfulness.” עָבַד (ah-VAHD)—to serve
 3. “Choose this day whom you will serve...” (v. 15) בָּחַר (bah-CHAR)—to choose.

Joshua 24:29-33 || Faithful servants die, but the covenant story continues.

- נַחֲלָה (nah-cha-LAH)—inheritance.
- עֵצָם (EH-tsem)—bone
- קָבַר (kah-VAR)—to bury

Call:

Christ is risen. The tomb is empty. The promise still stands.

Response:

We choose this day to serve the LORD.

Not by fear, but by faith.

Not in our strength, but in His resurrection power.

Call:

We are His people.

We are His witnesses.

We are His servants.

Response:

We will not shrink back.

We will not forget the promise.

We will remember what God has done.

Call:

As for me and my house...

We will serve the LORD!
